Will there be a cost for coaching? The studio will be covering the cost of coaches at the competition. Note that all instructors & Miss Mandy are volunteering their time. Please treat them accordingly.

What are the age divisions? 6 & Under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16
17 & up, adult 30+; ages may be divided or combined based on number of entries.

When & how is the age determined? Age on the first day of competition
Average age - duos/trios/groups

Are there ability levels? Yes - Novice (1 - 2 years of training);
Junior (3 - 5); Senior (6 or more)

What are the 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards? Glass Trophies, Medals and Cash Awards

When is the competition held? March 20 – 22 - Friday, Saturday and Sunday
afternoon and evening.

Will Star be staying in Banff? Staying in Banff is optional. The studio has booked a block of rooms in the Professional Development Centre and Lloyd Hall of the Banff Centre (\$135.00+GST/night) Phone number to follow to book your room. Deadline Feb 6th.

Can any Solo/Duet/Small Group attend? Yes.

Can Star groups not listed on the Competition Schedule for 2009 attend? No.
The classes that will be attending have already been decided.

Who can compete at Nationals? The studio will not be sending groups or a teacher to this competition. All routines that perform at a Regional competition qualify to compete at Nationals. Nationals will be held in Vancouver June 29 – July 3, 2009. Students who register their solos/duets/small groups before Dec 1 do not have to pay regional entry fees for that solo/duet/small group.
